YNOT is governed by an eleven (11) member skill-based Board. Board members must be committed to the objects, purposes, and guiding principles of the Association, outlined in our Constitution.

Please note that YNOT Board meetings are held bi-monthly from 12pm-1:30pm, the third Wednesday of the month. Most meetings occur online, with at least two meetings held in person. You need to be available to attend these meetings.

- Why you are interested in the role.
